### Key's Contribution

#### **Privilege**

*Noun: a right, immunity, or benefit enjoyed only by a person beyond the advantages of most.*

Over recent months, the word used most during prayers on the RoadHoG Bus and at the Project Local Management Team meetings, has been "**privilege**". We all feel privileged to be allowed to serve our Saviour by being allowed to work as part of the RoadHoG Project Team – in whatever capacity.

We've all been privileged to see God at work amongst the youngsters at the various Stops, in the building of relationships and privileged to witness His provision - that enables the work to continue. Privileged to be the recipients of fund raising by so many people to keep us on the road, but mainly privileged to be recipients of their prayers and their love.

And I feel particularly privileged to have met and worked alongside so many amazing Christian men and women – thank you all for your love and patience (if you've ever worked alongside me you'll know what that means...). Our last Stop of this season will be at Butterwick on the 31<sup>st</sup> July before we undertake all the work necessary for the Bus to pass her MOT (Friday 18<sup>th</sup> of August – please be in prayer for a clean bill of health for the old girl) and to attend to all the small jobs that a season has highlighted need doing. We return (by God's grace) – with both Team Members and RoadHoG Bus refreshed and raring to go - at Woad Farm on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> September.

It's been a wonderful season, with over 600 Young People visiting the Bus and forming relationships with one another and with the Team Members, and as our abilities and confidence has grown, so have the numbers of young people at each Stop! God never presents us with challenges He hasn't equipped us to face, or expects us to use gifts that He hasn't provided – as we have grown as individuals and as Teams, so have the number of youngsters – God is GOOD!

What of the next season? Well, we will stand or fall by claiming Paul's words to the Church at Philippi "***I can do all things through Jesus Christ who strengthens me***" (Philippians 4:13).

What are our plans for the next season?

That's simple - we will simply "***wait upon the lord***" and claim the promises of Isaiah 40:31, but above all, we will simply love the youngsters that God gives us and make every attempt to portray Jesus Christ in our every conversation with them and by our actions we will try to show them the Love of Jesus.

None of us are child psychology experts, or particularly gifted, but what marks out the RoadHoG Team Members from all others is our desire to witness to young people the privileges of being children of God – something that we all enjoy and which binds us together in Him.
