as you will see, things are progressing
nicely and we should be on track to
take delivery in February!

That leaves the Management Group with the problem of organising a Commissioning Service for the New Bus – and this is where we need your prayers please?

We believe that we need to obtain the maximum amount of publicity for the roadHoG Project as possible and also be able to say a huge "thank you" to all our funders, Church Leaders and supporters – and we especially need to thank our Lord God for His amazing blessings – and to seek His continued blessing on the Project going forward. So we're looking for something that is both "glitzy" and "worshipful" at the same time – hopefully you now see the problem?

Please pray that we'll know the right thing to do – and then do it? It will mean quite a lot of work for quite a lot of people, but if we follow The Lord's leading, then we should be able to give people a good time AND preach the good news of Jesus Christ to quite a large audience – so no pressure then......

- Being able to have a "chat" with a parent about their child and about our faith and see something of a relationship developing as they "accept" us and what we do - and question how they might explore their own journey towards faith.
- Folk giving up their time to attend a roadHoG training course and then watching them over the coming weeks get well and truly involved in the Project – and enjoying it.
- Seeing Team Members working across a number of Teams, whether just to help out on an occasional basis or enjoying what they do at their "own" Stop so much, that they want to be out on the Bus more often.
- Telling people about roadHoG and them saying that they've seen the Bus about on their own area – or better still – them tell me that they used to attend the Bus when they were younger (yes Tony – you are that old...!) and how much they enjoyed their time there and how much they learned whilst on the Bus.
- Almost running out of money, but never actually doing so – God's provision is amazing!
